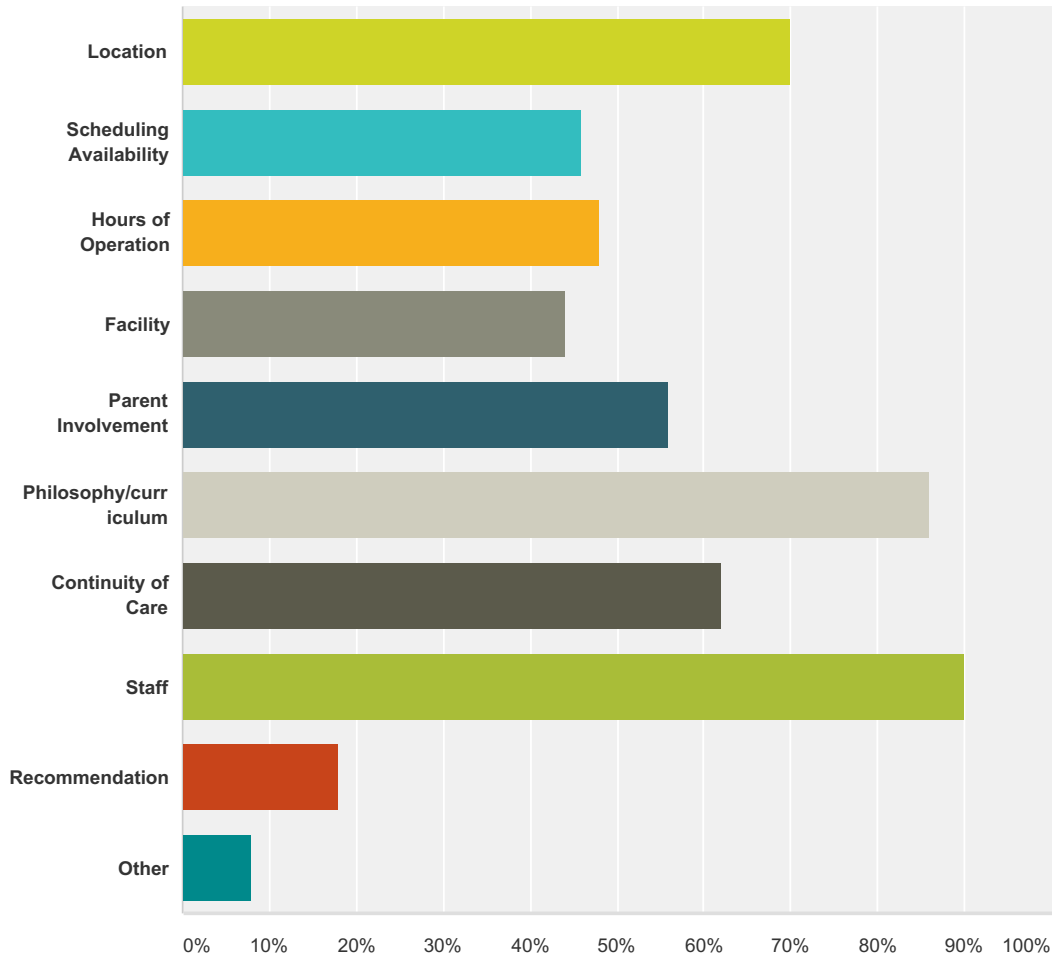

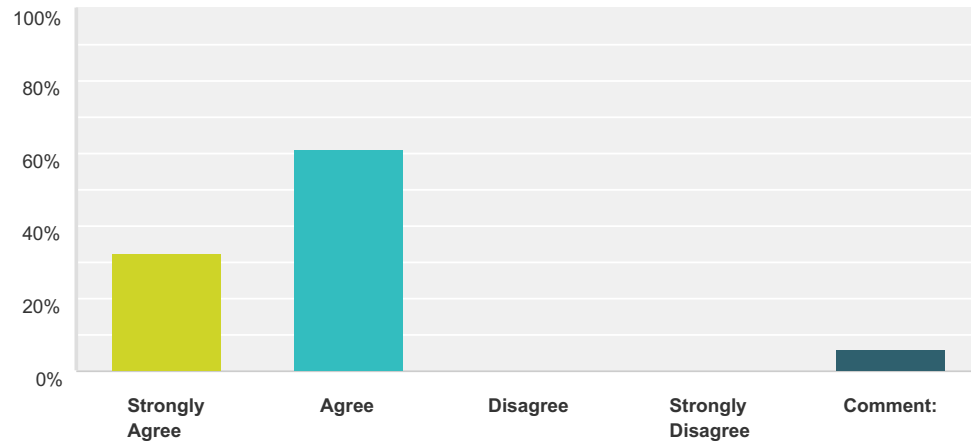

Q4 Have you received program forms and essential program information in a way that is accessible to you.

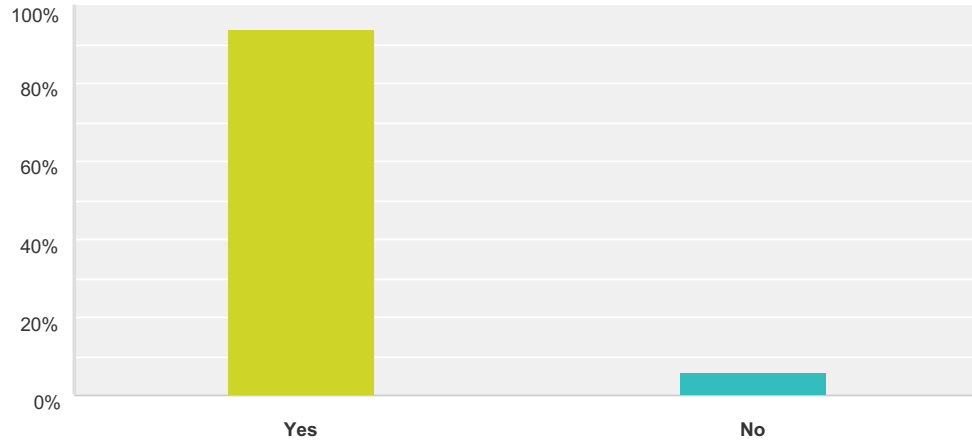

Q5 Do you feel adequately informed about the Co-op family Center policies, procedures and practices?

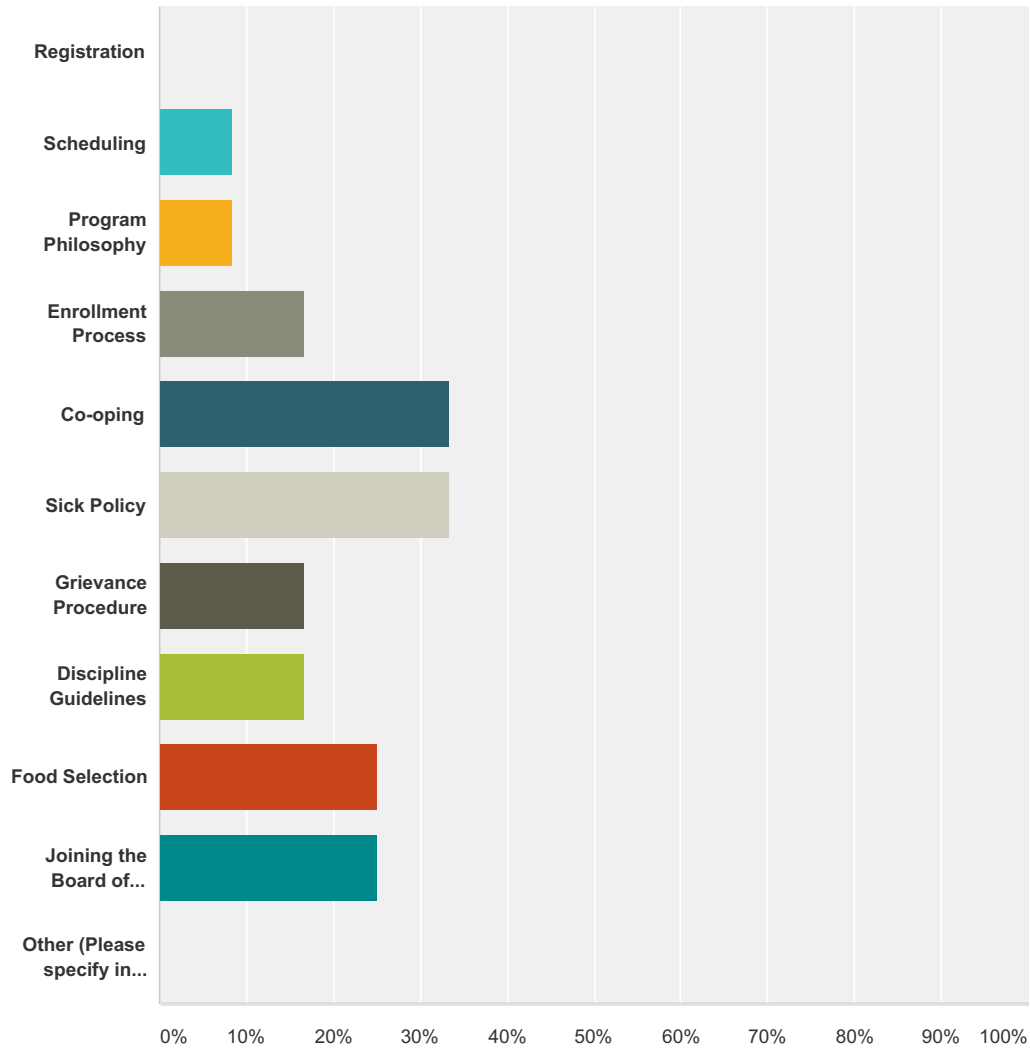

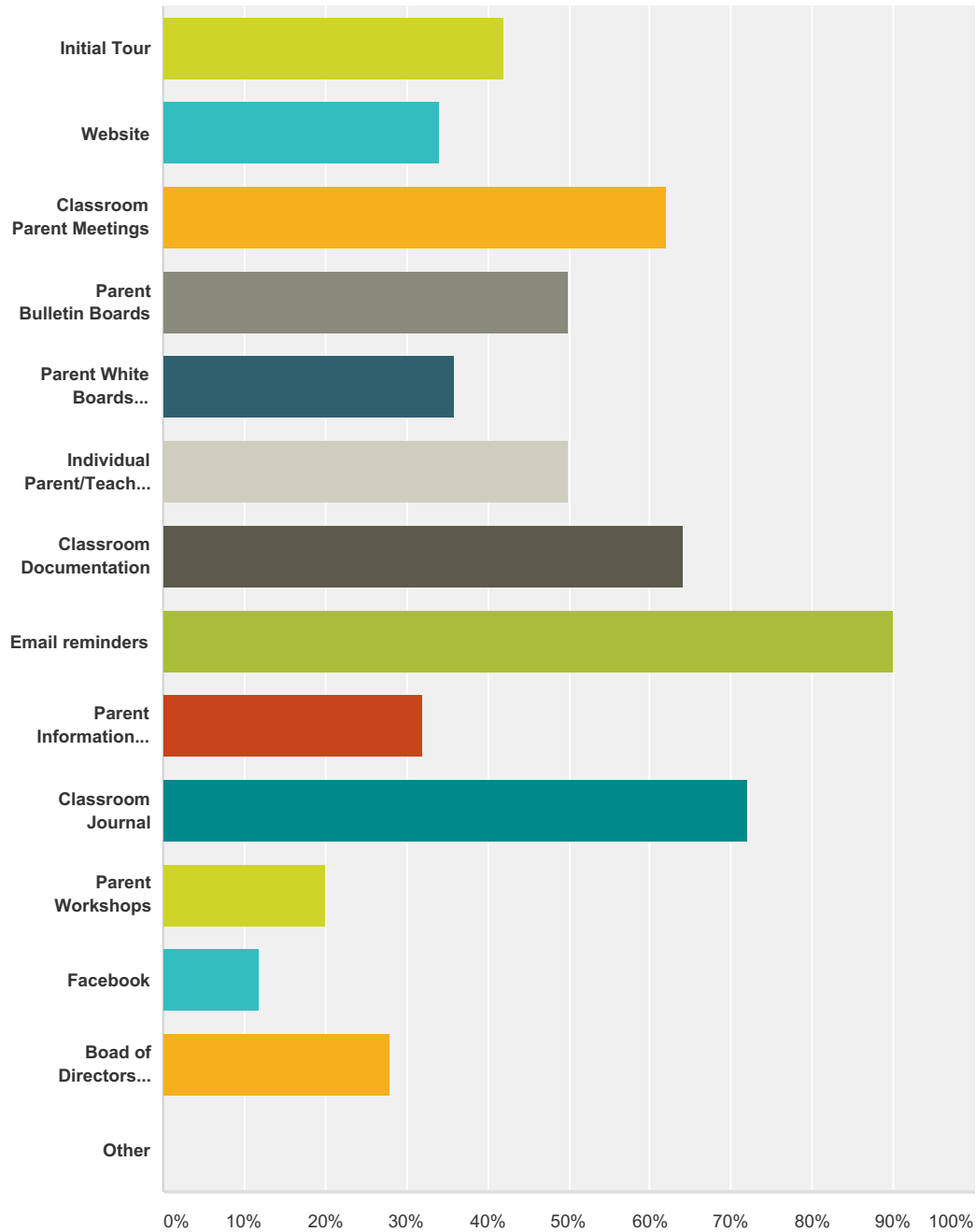

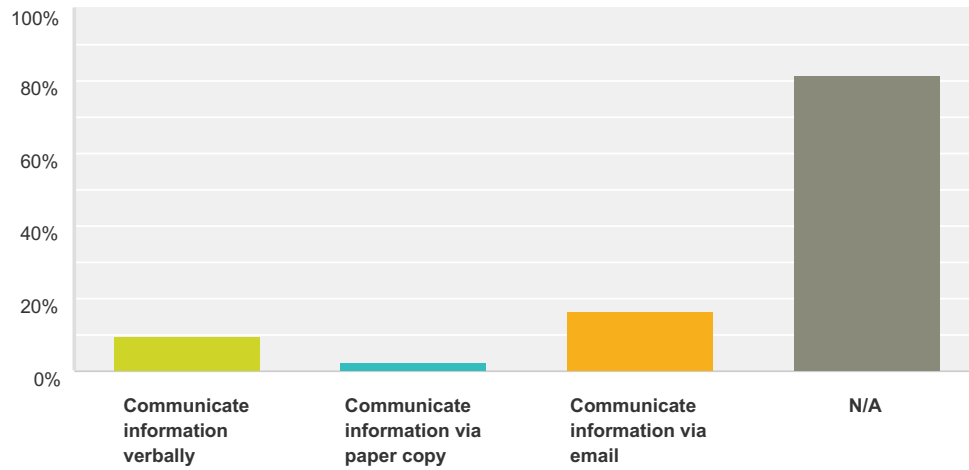

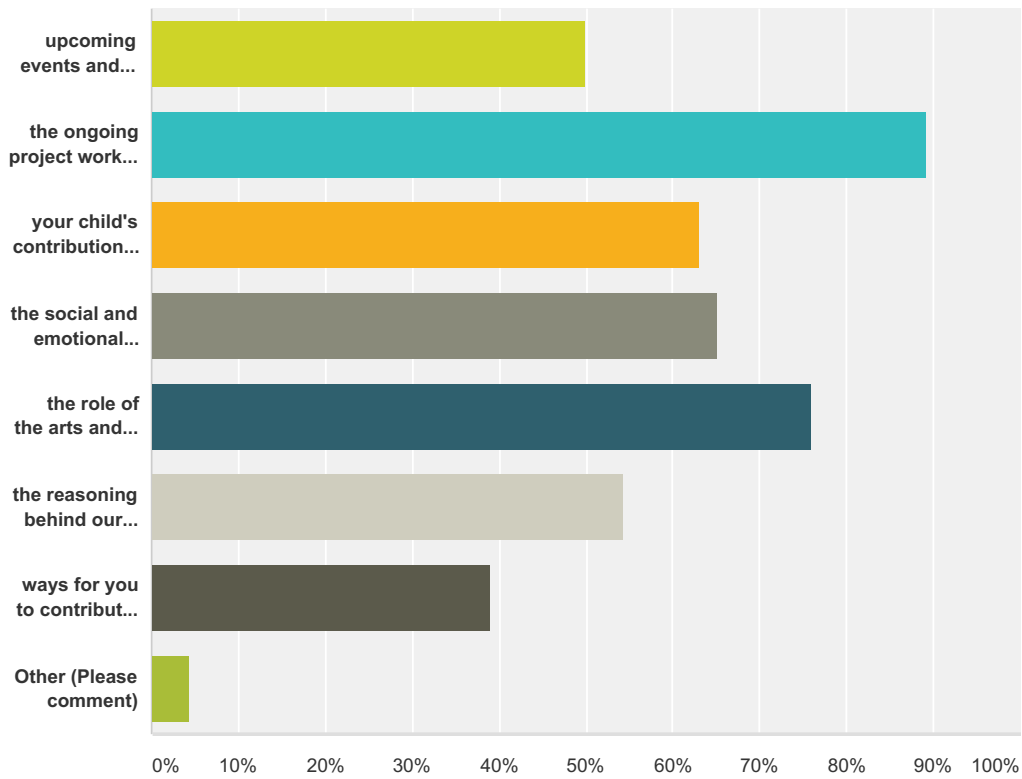

Q9 The Classroom Journal effectively communicates: (Check all that apply)

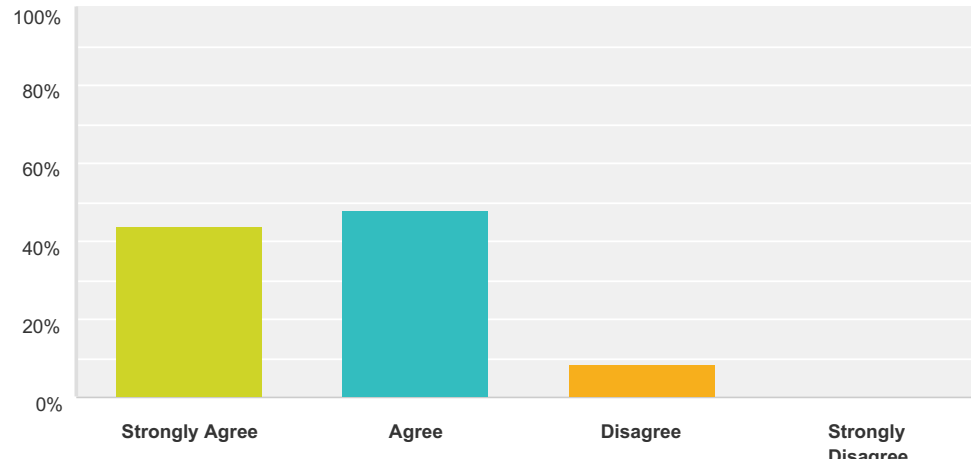

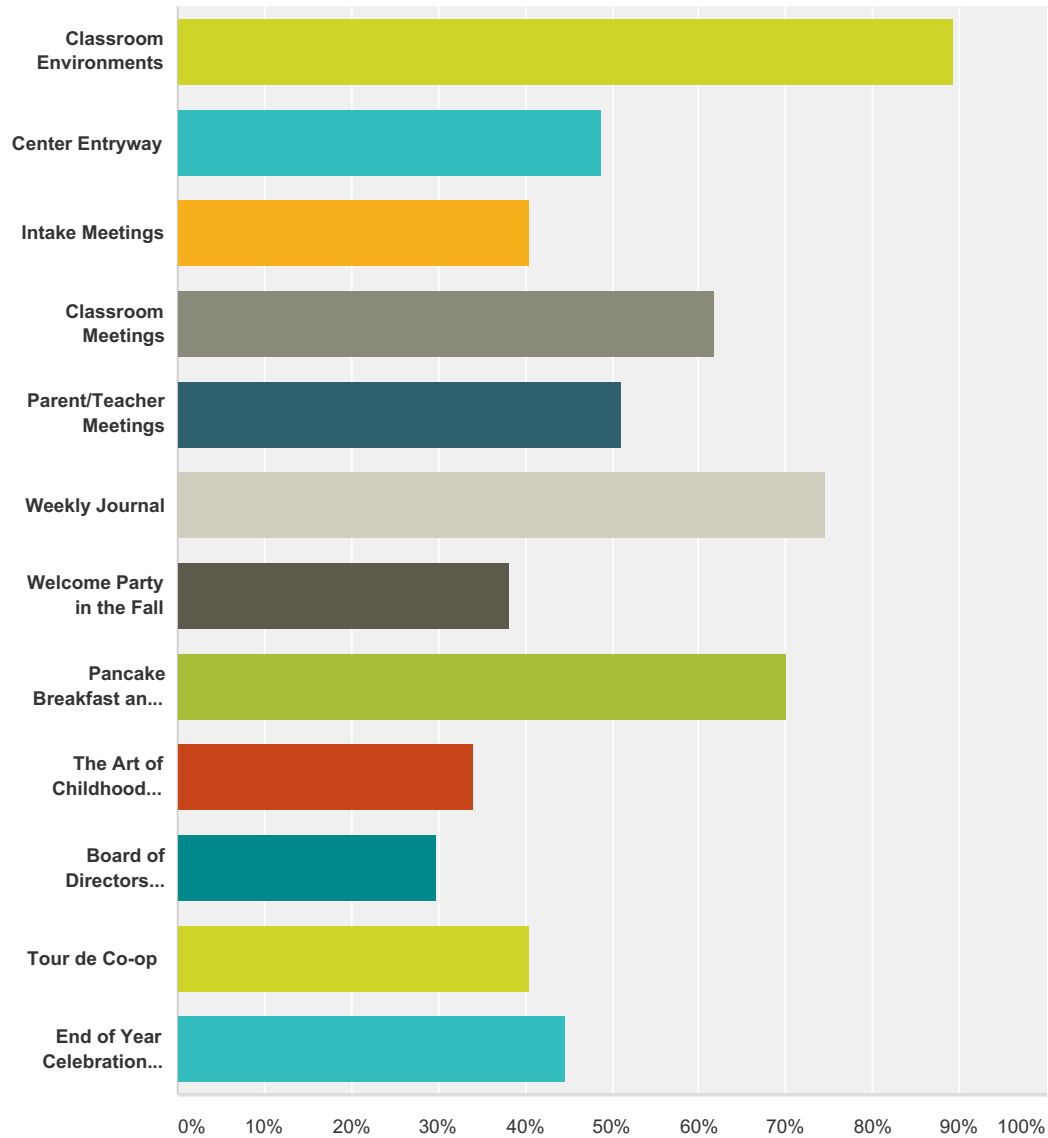

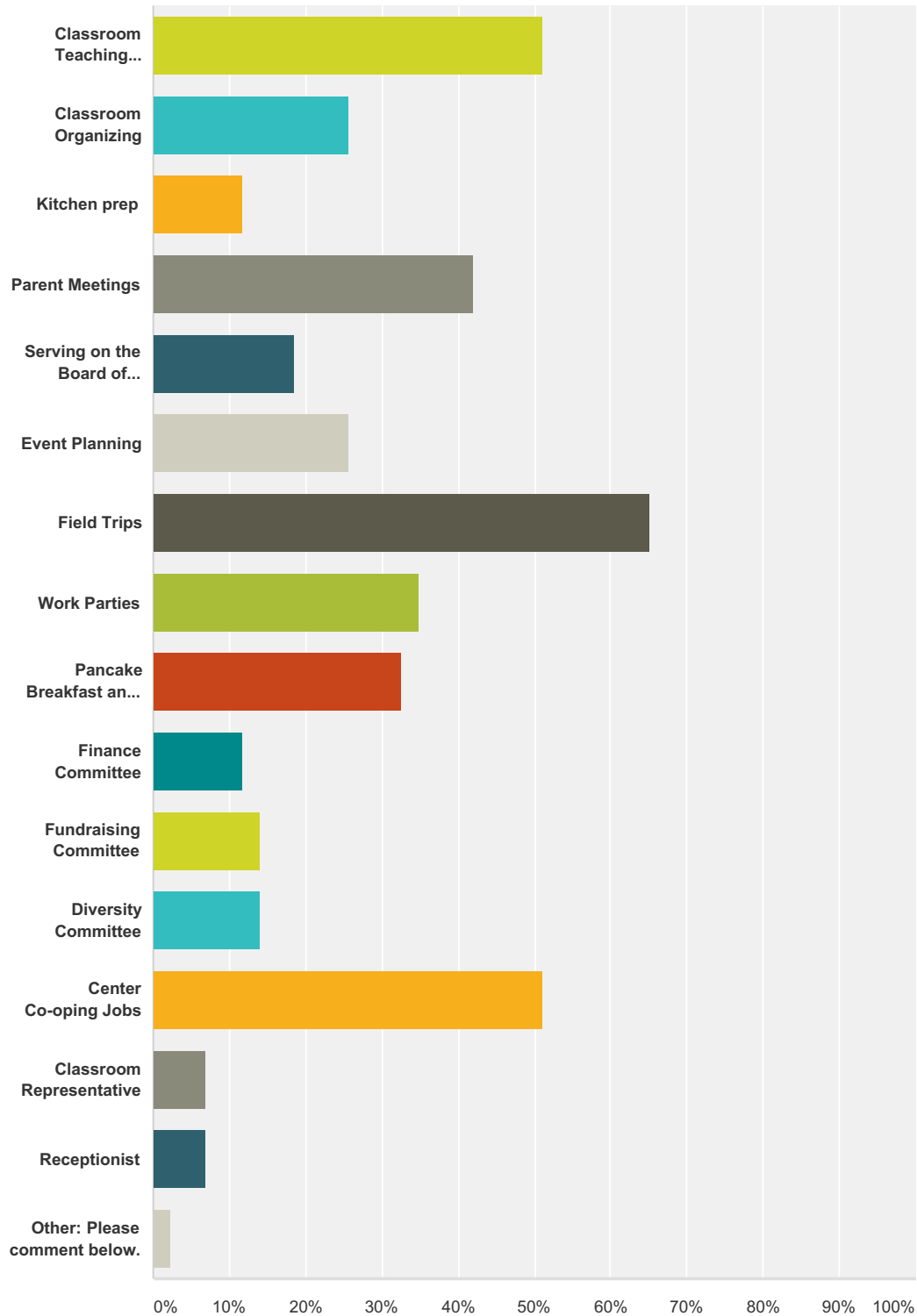

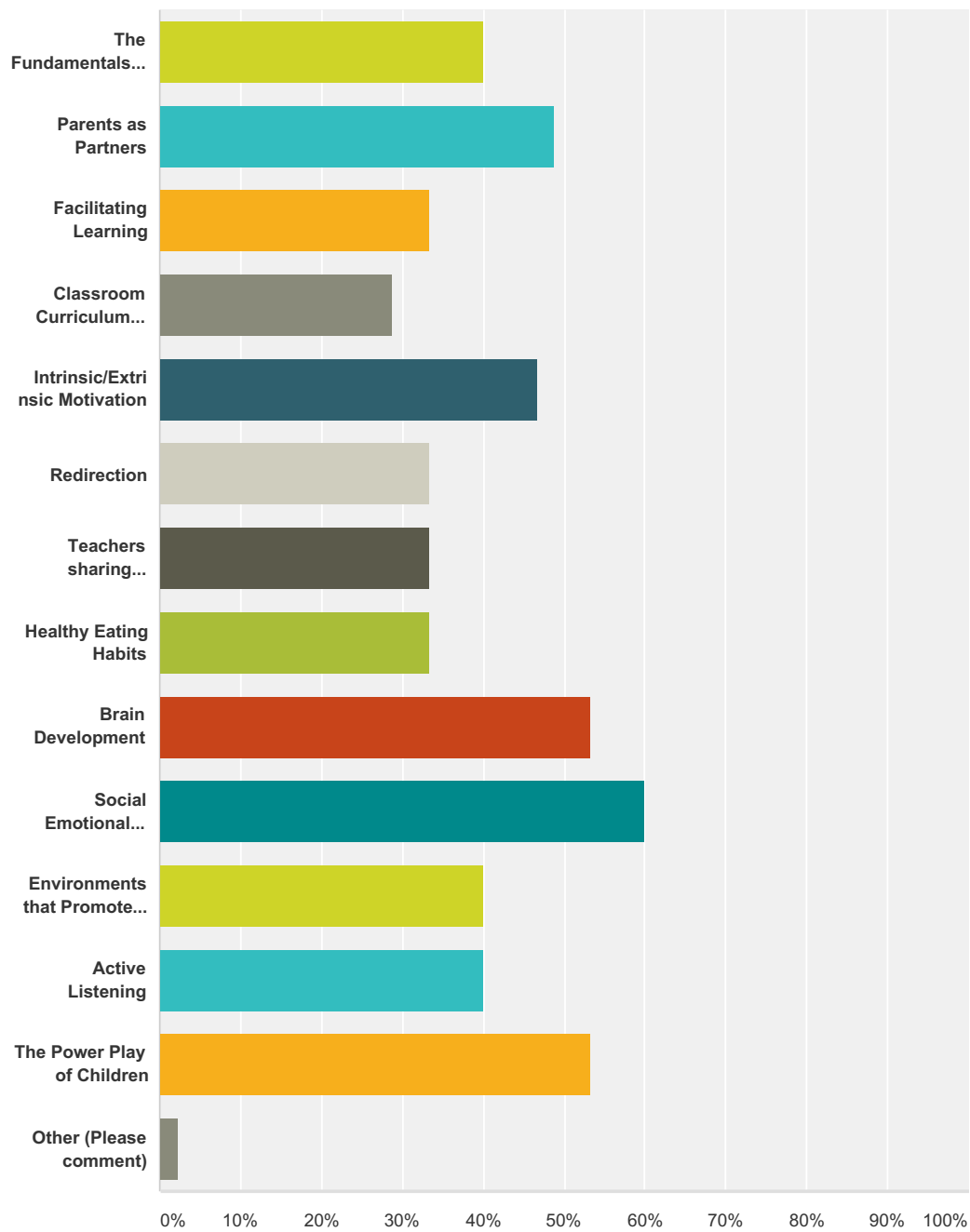

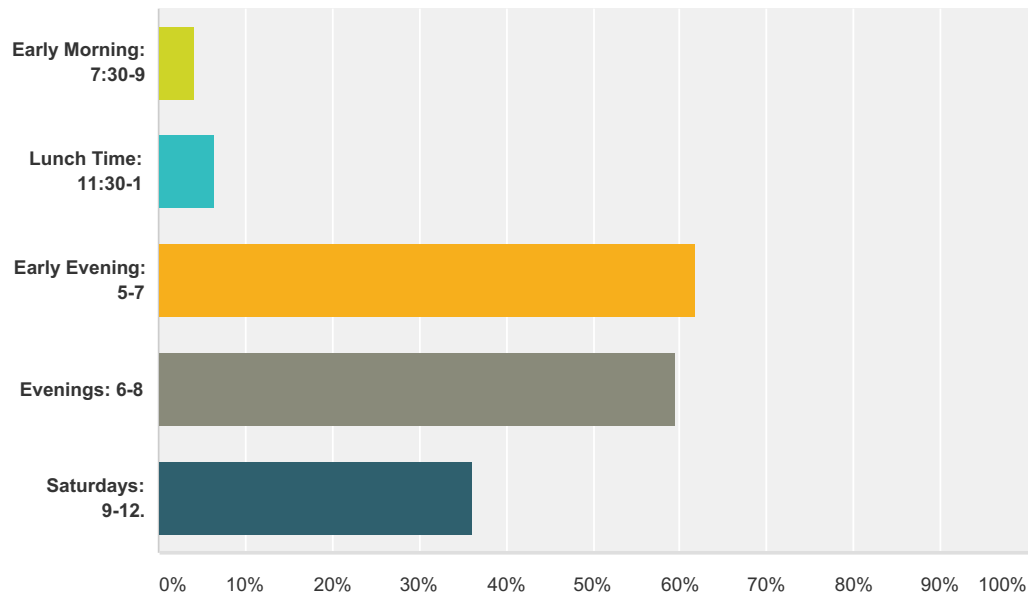

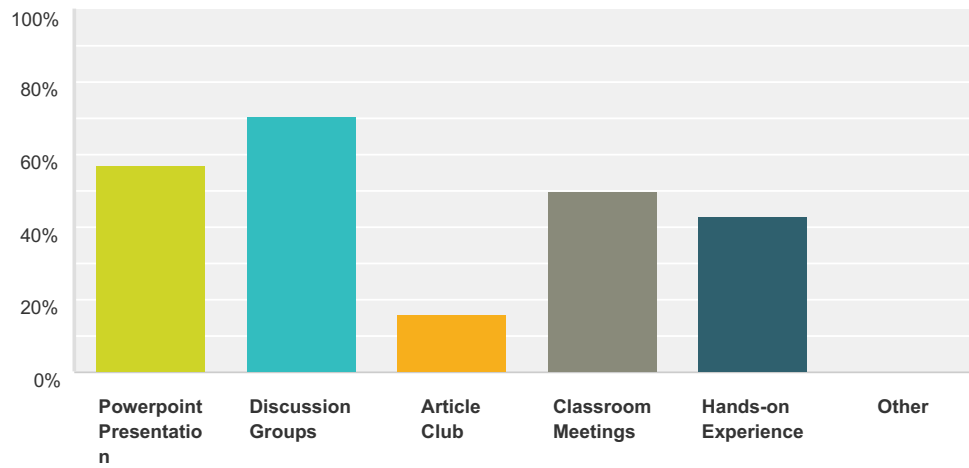
